
Experiment: Building Bridges (Teacher's Key)

What can you use to build a bridge? So many things. Here are some ideas:

- Popsicle sticks (hot glue, white glue, clay)
- Coffee stir sticks (elastics, yarn to tie)
- Straws (tape, clay)
- Cardboard tubes and cardboard (some glue)
- Toothpicks (gumdrops, marshmallows)
- Straws (pipe cleaners)
- Rolled up newspaper (masking tape)
- Construction paper (tape, glue stick, double sided tape)
- Lego
- Clamps to help hold it together while the glue dries:
 - Binder clips
 - Zip ties
 - Twist ties
 - Mini clamps






